

Petition Requirements for a Prop 218 Re-Vote:

Per City Council direction, if there is a desire for a re-vote for a new Proposition 218 assessment increase in any of the below Zones, residents can petition for a re-vote. There is no official format for the petition. However, petitions should include the street address, printed owner's name, and signature. Please include the Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) for each property if known. A spreadsheet with APNs and corresponding street addresses is available from the Public Works Department (714.961.7170) upon request. The information on the spreadsheet was obtained from the County of Orange and may not reflect recent changes to parcels. Other petition formats may be considered by the City Council. The signature level is established at more than 50% of the total number of ballots received in the last balloting process for the respective Zones. This requirement includes one signature per parcel since there is only one vote allowed per parcel. The deadline for submitting said petition is September 12, 2016 at 5:30 PM. Please return petitions to the City Clerk's office at City Hall (4845 Casa Loma Avenue). Please contact the City at (714) 961-7170 with any questions.
