

CITY COUNCIL ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

JUNE 10, 2009

CALL TO ORDER

The City Council convened at 7:06 p.m. at the Yorba Room in the Community Center at 4501 Casa Loma Avenue, Yorba Linda.

REPORT, DISCUSSION AND DIRECTION – FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 BUDGET INCLUDING 2009-2010 – 2015-2016 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Interim City Manager Kelly presented an overview of the proposed Fiscal Year 2009-2010 City of Yorba Linda and Yorba Linda Redevelopment Agency Budget.

Council discussion ensued regarding the budget including the Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District's cancellation of summer school resulting in possible crossing guard cost savings, tree trimming schedules, NPDES requirements, capturing Redevelopment Agency charges, and personnel costs.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Bob Hansohn, resident, questioned how the budget cuts in public safety will impact services and asked that the quality of service not be diminished.

Brea Police Department Captain Conklin responded to questions of the City Council and public.

Tom Lynch, resident, asked about the depreciation of the Black Gold Golf Course.

Interim City Manager Kelly presented the proposed City of Yorba Linda Capital Improvement Program for 2009-2010 – 2015-2016.

Council discussion ensued regarding capital improvement funding sources, funding for the La Palma Rehabilitation project, and park improvements. In addition, there was discussion of additional projects such as July 4th fireworks show, Fiesta Days parade, flags and banners on major streets, hiring a lobbyist firm to represent the City at the State and Federal level, sponsoring local high schools' graduation night, and the equestrian center and fund.

Mary Lewis, resident, urged Council to decide on "need" versus "want" and said the 4th of July and Fiesta Days events are "wants" while street repairs and police officers on the streets are "needs".

Claudine Lynch, resident, stated what she can give up. She expressed her expectation that City Council take cuts and that taking people's jobs is wrong.

Lee Day, resident, spoke in support of the equestrian center.

Doug Knarr, resident, spoke of the 1993 General Plan which did not include an equestrian center, dog park or skateboard park.

The City Council/RDA convened into Closed Session at 9:35 p.m.
