In partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank of Orange County, the Yorba Linda Parks and Recreation Department offers the Senior Grocery Program, a twice-a-month “pop-up market” where senior attendees can select from various grocery items, including fresh produce, dairy, deli meats, eggs, and canned goods. No registration is required and there are no income requirements.

Tips for Success at the Senior Grocery Program:



- Heavy or bulky items may be distributed; 3-4 reusable grocery bags are recommended per person. A personal cart is also recommended.
- Attendees will receive a number in the order they arrive. This will be the order food is distributed. Doors open and numbers are distributed at 7:30 a.m. Distribution of food begins at 8:30 a.m.
- Refrigerated/perishable items will be distributed. Plan to head straight home to distribute your refrigerated items.
- Distributed items are at, or close to, their “sell by” date. Items should be checked carefully for freshness prior to consuming.
