Year Round Volunteer Program (for High School Students)

This Year Round Volunteer Program is designed to assist Yorba Linda residents in grades 9-12 complete their community service requirements and give them an opportunity to get involved in their community. TAC - Teen Action Committee (7-8 Grades)

The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking enthusiastic and responsible 7-8 grade middle school students to serve on the Teen Action Committee (TAC). The purpose of the TAC program is to provide leadership, recreational, educational, and social opportunities to middle school students during non-school hours. TAC members will assist in planning, organizing, marketing, and implementing a variety of teen activities and events designed for the teens in the community. Applications are also available from the Activities Directors at Bernardo Yorba, Travis Ranch, and Yorba Linda Middle Schools. This program has specific application dates and teacher recommendations are required as part of the application process. Application are usually released in February with the deadline in April. Summer Volunteer Program (Ages 14-17)

The City of Yorba Linda is seeking active and responsible Yorba Linda teens, 14-17 years old, interested in recreation and working with youth. The purpose of the Volunteer Program is to provide mentorship, leadership, and hands-on training for Yorba Linda teens. Staff will emphasize leadership development, teamwork, and professionalism. Volunteers will work side by side with the Recreation staff in planning and facilitating the City's summer recreational programs and camps. Volunteers must be able to commit to working all hours assigned, with the exception of up to two weeks of preapproved vacation time. After successful completion of the Volunteer Program, each Volunteer will receive verification of their service hours and may receive a monetary scholarship based on the number of hours volunteered and quality of work. Volunteers will be selected for their assignments based on their maturity, skill sets, leadership experience, and schedule availability. Priority will be given to Yorba Linda residents.
