

Do Not Knock Registry

The City of Yorba Linda City Council passed an ordinance regulating solicitation within Yorba Linda. Effective October 21, 2010, all persons, businesses and organizations wishing to solicit in Yorba Linda for any money, funds or contributions are required to obtain a permit. Upon permit approval, commercial solicitors will be issued permanent ID cards and will be required to keep them displayed at all times. Political, religious and charitable organizations are not required to obtain a permit unless the contact involves the solicitation of money, funds or contributions. **All solicitors are prohibited from soliciting at any location listed on the “Do Not Knock Registry” or from any location with a sign posted prohibiting solicitation.**

The new ordinance requires all solicitors to obtain a current “Do Not Knock Registry” list on the first of each month. The “Do Not Knock Registry” will work similarly to a “Do Not Call” list and will prohibit solicitation at registered addresses. For your protection, only addresses and expiration dates will appear on the Do Not Knock list. **If you would like your address to appear on the “Do Not Knock Registry” list, please contact the City Clerk’s office at (714) 961-7150 or email us with your name and address at mbrown@yorba-linda.org.** Your registration will become effective on the first day of the month following registration and must be renewed annually.

Stickers indicating inclusion on the “Do Not Knock Registry” are available for purchase at City Hall. A sticker is not required for those listed on the Registry, but is highly recommended in helping prevent unwanted solicitation. The entire ordinance, is available by clicking [here](#). Solicitation is **Not**

- Communication that is political, religious, or charitable in nature - AND - does not involve solicitation of money, funds, contributions, or anything of value
- Delivery of items ordered by resident or business (newspapers, groceries, etc.)
- Dissemination of information, such as real estate flyers, business cards, pamphlets, etc.

"No Solicitation" stickers and signs indicating inclusion on the "Do Not Knock" Registry are available for purchase at City Hall. A sticker or sign is not required for those listed on the Registry, but may be helpful to prevent unwanted solicitors.

- Sticker (3" x 8") - \$1.00
- Static Cling (3" x 8") - \$1.50
