



SR-57 Northbound Widening Project CONSTRUCTION ALERT

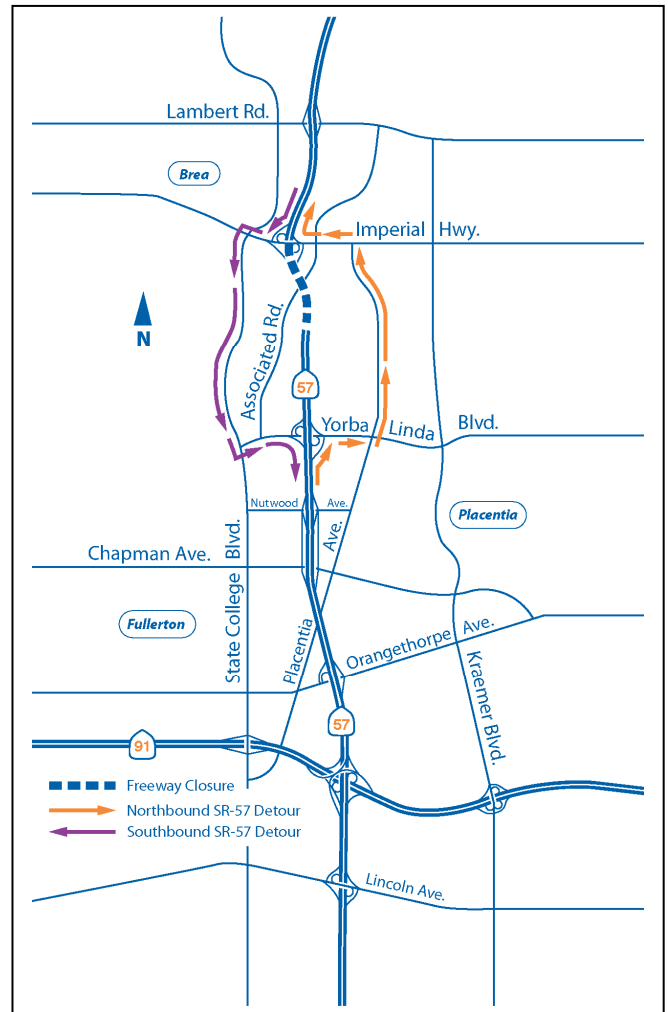
Nighttime Full Freeway Closure – May 22, 2011
NB: Yorba Linda Blvd. to Imperial Hwy.
SB: Imperial Hwy. to Yorba Linda Blvd.

WHAT: Southern California Edison workers will close the SR-57 freeway to continue moving back power poles and relocating electrical power lines across the second of three bridges during nighttime work sessions on consecutive Sundays into July. The remaining bridges are located at Associated Rd. and Orangethorpe Ave. During the first power line relocation across the Associated Rd. overhead bridge, the freeway will fully close between Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Hwy. going northbound and from Imperial Hwy. to Yorba Linda Blvd. going southbound for this nighttime work.

WHEN: Southern California Edison will begin working to relocate the poles from 7 p.m. on Saturday, May 21 to 11 a.m. on Sunday, May 22. The first full freeway closure to begin the work at the Associated Rd. overhead bridge will take place on May 22 from 1 a.m. - 5 a.m. Both Yorba Linda Blvd. and Imperial Hwy. ramps will close at midnight. Details about upcoming closures at the Orangethorpe Ave. bridge, which will extend into July, will be sent via weekly construction alerts and posted online. Please note that work will not take place over Memorial Day weekend.

DETOUR: Detours will be clearly marked with posted and electronic message signs for motorists to follow. Going southbound, traffic will be redirected from the Imperial Hwy. off ramp, south on State College Blvd. and east on Yorba Linda Blvd. The northbound detour will redirect traffic from the Yorba Linda Blvd. off ramp to north on Placentia Ave. and west on Imperial Hwy.
