Yorba Linda City Council Election Nomination Period to Open

Yorba Linda, CA - Persons interested in running for the office of City Council Member for the City of Yorba Linda in the upcoming November election may obtain Nomination Papers and a Candidate's Packet from the City Clerk's office beginning Monday, July 12, 2010 at 7:30 a.m.

Tuesday, November 2, 2010 has been set by the Yorba Linda City Council as the date for the City's General Election to fill two seats on the City Council for four-year terms. The incumbents presently occupying those offices are John Anderson and Jan Horton. The successful candidates will be installed in the month of December 2010.

To be eligible to hold office as a City Council Member, a person must be 18 years old and a registered voter residing within the boundaries of the City of Yorba Linda.

Each Nomination Paper must be signed by at least 20 and no more than 30 persons who are registered to vote in the City of Yorba Linda. Nomination signatures can be collected between July 12, 2010 and August 6, 2010. If any incumbent has not filed Nomination Papers by Friday, August 6, 2010 at 5:00 p.m., the nominating period will be extended to Wednesday, August 11, 2010 at 5:30 p.m. for all interested persons other than incumbents.

Each candidate is required to file a Statement of Economic Interests disclosing investments, income, business positions, and interests in real property when the Nomination Papers are returned for filing. There is no charge for filing Nomination Papers.

Candidates may also prepare a Statement that may include their name and a brief description of no more than 200 words setting forth the candidate's

education and qualifications. The Statement is filed with the Nomination Papers and is included in the sample ballot materials mailed to voters. The charge to each candidate for providing this service is estimated to be \$946 and is payable at the time of filing Nomination Papers.

All forms required for nomination and election to municipal office in the City of Yorba Linda are furnished by and filed with the Yorba Linda City Clerk. Appointments to obtain the Nomination Papers are highly recommended to insure ample time to thoroughly review the filing requirements and answer any questions. The process takes approximately 30 minutes.

The City Clerk's office is located at 4845 Casa Loma Avenue, Yorba Linda, and is open between 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, and closed on alternate Fridays.
